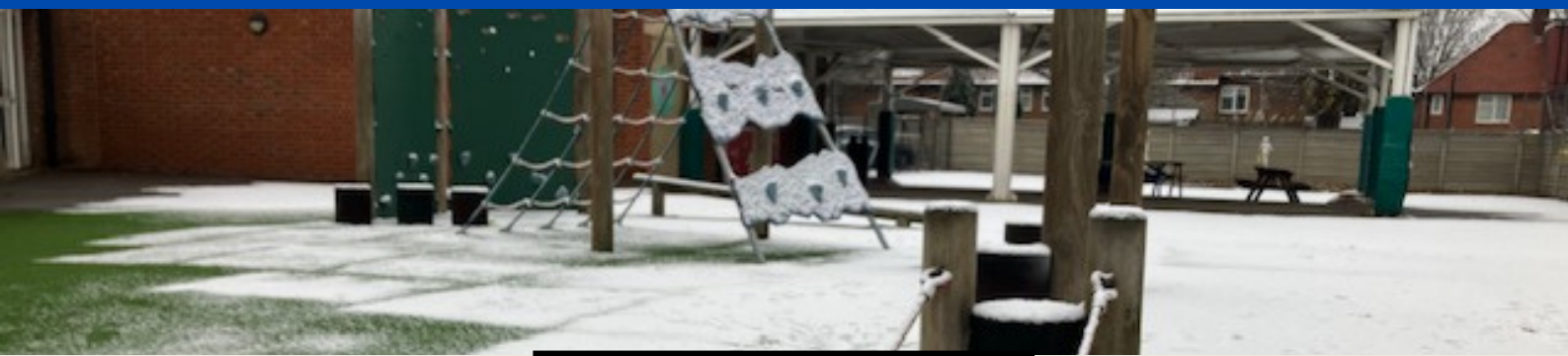


# André Malraux Newsletter
