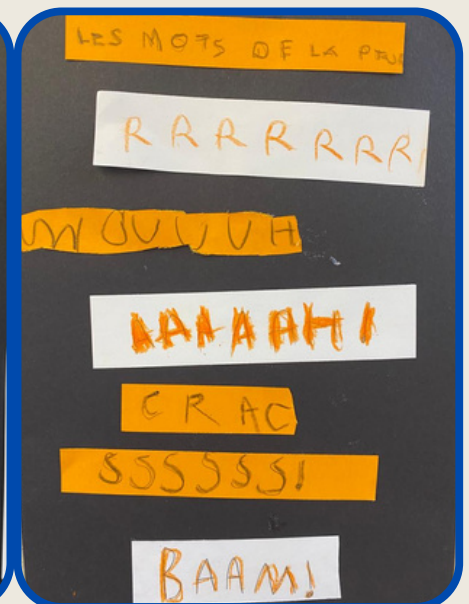


After weeks of hard work, we were glad our pupils could have some well-deserved fun. Halloween was an excellent occasion to experience a day out of the ordinary.

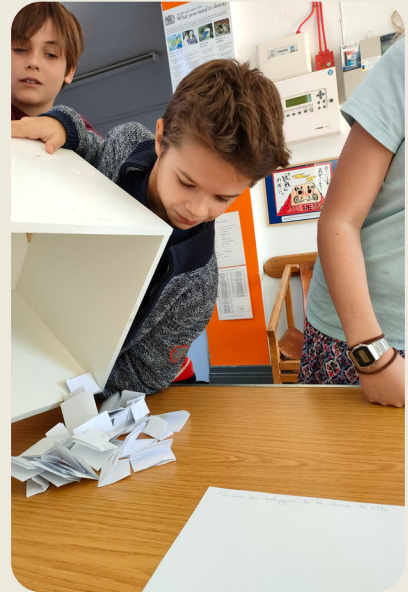
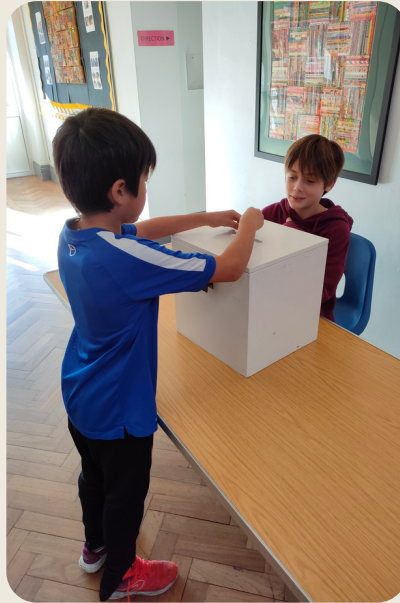


GS work on the Halloween theme

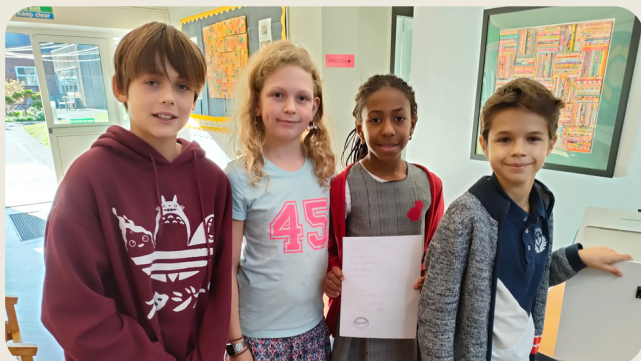
# Class Reps

# Safeguarding

In the United Kingdom, all organisations working in contact with children must have protective policies and procedures to ensure that every child has equal protection against abuse.

## What is safeguarding?

Safeguarding is:

- protecting children from abuse and maltreatment
- preventing harm to children's health or development
- ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care
- taking action to enable all children and young people to have the best outcomes

## In our school?

All staff members take a safeguarding training which is updated every year. Each staff member knows that they have a role to play in protecting children and knows the steps to take to respond to different types of situations.
