





BACK TO SCHOOL 2023 - SOUTH KENSINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The start of the school year will be **on Tuesday 5th September, 2023,** for all classes in the school.

On that day, exceptionally, parents will be allowed to enter the school - in successive waves depending on their child's class level - to discover the class lists and briefly meet their child's teacher. You will find below the details of the planned organization.

START OF THE SHOOL YEAR FOR ELEMENTARY PUPILS

On the first day of school, elementary school pupils and their parents will enter the playground **through Gate B** at a specific time according to their year group (see below). Class lists will be posted in the playground. Teachers will welcome pupils and parents before going to class.

START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR MS and GS PUPILS (Reception and Year 1)

The specific timetable for your child will be sent to you by email before the summer holidays.

Tuesday 5th September: for their 1st day of school, MS and GS pupils will spend half a day in class, by half-group: the 1st half-group will come in the morning; the 2nd half-group will come in the afternoon. **There will be no canteen on this day**.

On that day, exceptionally, the parents will enter with their child in the Maternelle playground through gate A. They will be welcomed by their teacher and the teaching assistant, then the parents will leave the playground and the pupils will go up to class. At the end of the half-day, the exit will be at gate A.

From Wednesday 6th September: The whole class will be welcomed for half day. Parents will drop off their child and pick them up at Gate A after lunch, where the teacher and Teaching assistant will be present.

START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR PS PUPILS (Nursery)

The start of the school year will be spread over several days to facilitate the good adaptation of the pupils. Below you will find the specific times for each child. **The specific timetable for your child will be sent to you by email before the summer holidays.**

Tuesday 5th September: PS pupils will be welcomed into the class for approximately 1 hour 15 minutes, in two successive half-groups in the morning. A parent can <u>stay with their child in the class</u>. Entrance and exit are via 14 Harrington road. **There will be no canteen that day**.







Wednesday 6th September: Group A: PS pupils will stay in school. A parent can drop off their child <u>at</u> <u>the threshold of the class</u>, then leave them. Entrance and exit will be via 14 Harrington road. There will be no canteen that day.

Thursday 7th September: Group B: PS pupils will stay in school. A parent can drop off their child <u>at the</u> <u>threshold of the class</u>, then leave them. Entrance and exit will be via 14 Harrington road. **There will be no canteen that day**.

Friday 8th **September**: parents will <u>drop off their child at 14 Harrington Road</u>, where the teacher and the teacher's assistant of the class will be waiting for them. Students will stay in class for half day and **will have lunch in the canteen.**

From Monday 11th September: parents will <u>drop off their child at 14 Harrington Road</u>, where the teacher and the teacher's assistant of the class will be waiting for them. Students will stay in class for the entire day and **will have lunch in the canteen.**

Before-school care

A paid daycare service welcomes students every morning from 8 am. The registration form must be returned to the school secretary by email: <u>secretariat.primairesk@lyceefrancais.org.uk</u>. There will be no daycare service on Tuesday 5th September, the first day of school. The daycare service will welcome children from **Wednesday 6th September at 8 am**.

The after-school activities of the Loisirs à l'école association will begin from Wednesday 6th September 2023. These activities incur a fee and are open to children upon registration. 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
