A Staff Question of the Week

A cybersecurity question this week: What is the meaning of phishing, smishing, vishing and quishing?

Phishing - a malicious email encouraging you to click on a link with the aim of collecting your details or downloading malicious code. Smishing - a text message (SMS) to encouraging you to click on a link with the aim of collecting your details or transferring you to a fake website. Vishing - an unsolicited telephone call to collect your details or defraud you.
