The aim of these Newsletters, which we hope to send out at the end of each term, is to highlight some of the important moments in the life of our school, so that you can share them with your children.

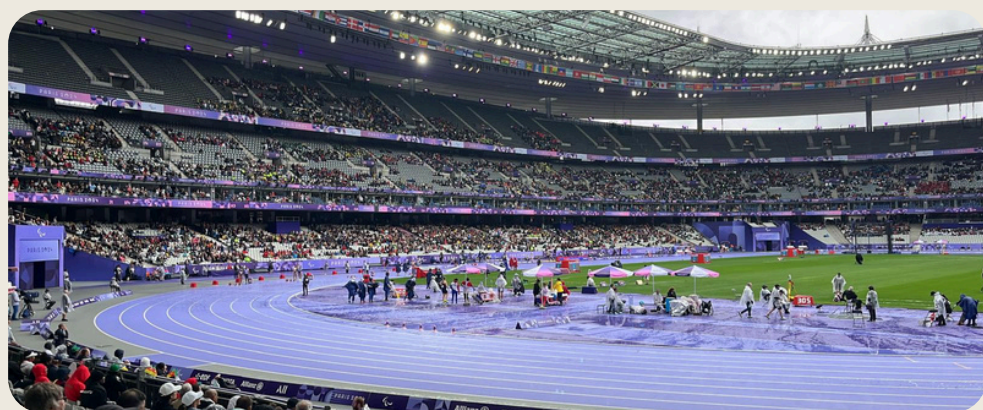


Paralympic games
